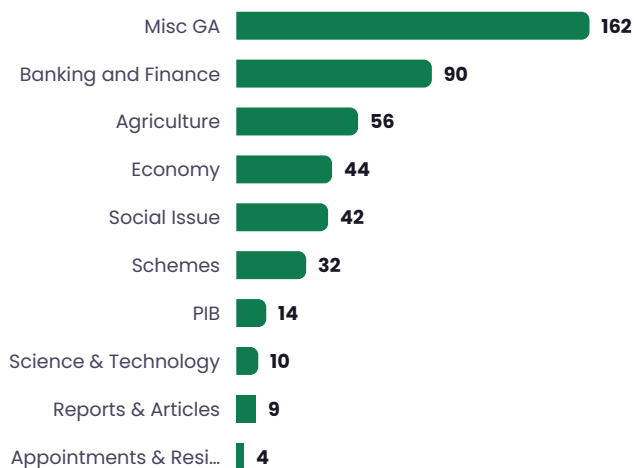

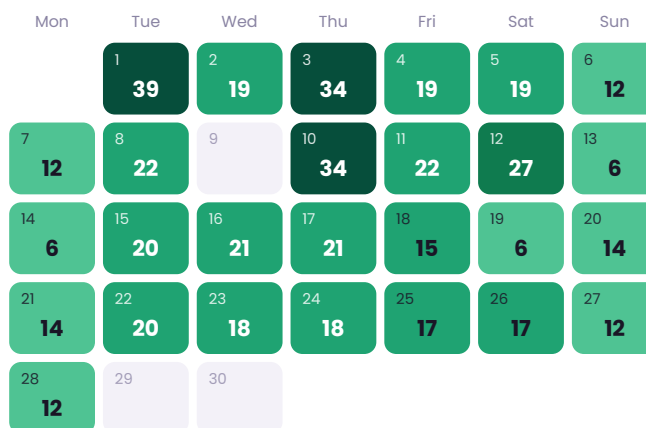

Items per day



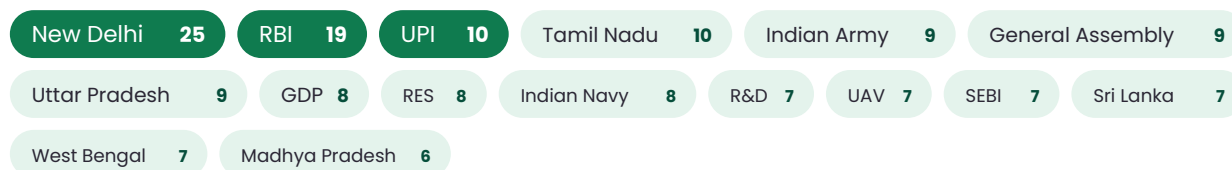

Hanging Glaciers

1 September 2026

- A study identified 219 hanging glaciers in Uttarakhand's Alaknanda basin, warning that warming and permafrost thaw are increasing break-off risks — potentially triggering ice-rock avalanches and outburst floods.
- Glacial retreat: Warming causes trunk/valley glaciers to thin and retreat, disconnecting smaller tributary glaciers → leaving them perched high on mountain walls.
- Thermal destabilisation: Rising temperatures thaw permafrost and basal ice, producing meltwater that lubricates the glacier-bedrock interface → making hanging glaciers unstable and prone to collapse.

NCDEX Launches RAINCHNNAI Weather Derivative

1 September 2026

- It covers the North-East/retreating monsoon during September–December.

ICAR-IIOR National Consultation on Oilseed Technology

1 September 2026

- ICAR–Indian Institute of Oilseeds Research (ICAR–IIOR), Hyderabad will organise a national consultation on 10 September 2026.

Global Coral Reefs Under Stress: GCRMN Report

2 September 2026

- Global hard coral cover has declined by about 9.5% compared with the 1980–2009 reference period.
- In 2024, around 87% of coral reefs experienced unprecedented heat stress.
- In 2025, this figure was 27.4%.
- Global hard coral cover declined by 8.9% between 2023 and 2024, the largest single-year relative decline recorded.

Pichavaram Mangroves: ₹2,485 Crore Economic Value

2 September 2026

- Study estimated the Total Economic Value (TEV) of Pichavaram mangroves at ₹2,485.38 crore.
- Per-hectare value: ₹1.83 crore; soil organic carbon stock is 251.14 tonnes/ha.
- Total blue carbon asset value: ₹1,612.40 crore, around 65% of total economic value.

UNCCD COP17 – Drought Resilience and Rangelands

3 September 2026

- 17th Session of UNCCD COP17 was held in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia, from 17–28 August 2026.
- Coincided with the UN International Year of Rangelands and Pastoralists (IYRP 2026).
- Next COP: Egypt will host UNCCD COP18 in 2028 at Sharm El-Sheikh.
- Drought Resilience Investment Facility (DRIF) – aims to mobilise up to USD 400 million for drought resilience.

NABARD-IMD MoU on Climate-Resilient Agriculture via DiCRA

4 September 2026

- Web portals — for institutional users
- Mobile interfaces — for farmers and field staff
- APIs — allowing banks, insurers and agri-tech firms to pull data into their own systems
- It served as the digital infrastructure for NABARD's National Climate Stack Innovation Challenge, where SatSure, EXPERIQS and VARSAPRADAYA built village-level climate risk tools on it

5 September 2026

- Fostering collaboration among innovators, investors, industry and government
- Helping startups understand investors' expectations
- And giving investors deeper insight into biotechnology's scientific, regulatory and development pathways

UNEP Limiting Overshoot Report

5 September 2026

- WMO estimates a 75% probability that the 2026–2030 average will exceed 1.5°C.
- Food security: Food production could decline by up to 14% by 2050 without adequate adaptation.
- Climate overshoot means global temperature temporarily exceeds 1.5°C, reaches a peak, and later declines.
- Only around 130 GtCO₂ remains in the carbon budget for a 50% chance of limiting warming to 1.5°C.

Ophiopogon japonicus Recorded in India for the First Time

6 & 7 September 2026

- Recorded at an elevation of 2,185 metres in West Kameng district, Arunachal Pradesh
- Documented by researchers from the Wildlife Institute of India (Dehradun) and the Uluberia Botanical Institute Herbarium, West Bengal
- Described as a significant find highlighting the biodiversity of the Eastern Himalaya

Osbeckia ulotricha: New Plant Species Discovered in Western Ghats

8 September 2026

- It occurs in shola grasslands and montane ecosystems of Kerala and Tamil Nadu at around 1,200–1,500 metres elevation.
- The discovery highlights the floral biodiversity and conservation importance of the Western Ghats.

IMF G20 Report on Strong, Sustainable, Balanced and Inclusive Growth

8 September 2026

- The IMF's latest SSBIG report estimates medium-term

G20 growth at only 3%, close to its weakest level since the framework began in 2009.

- Around half of G20 advanced economies face growth constraints because of restrictive labour, product or consumer-market regulations.
- Nearly three-fourths of G20 emerging-market economies also face regulatory constraints.
- The report stresses regulatory and institutional reforms to encourage private investment, public investment and long-term economic growth.

PACT Platform Launched for Zero-Emission Freight

8 September 2026

- NITI Aayog Member Rajiv Gauba launched the Platform for Aggregating Clean Transport (PACT) at the 5th e-FAST India Summit 2026.
- The summit also introduced the ZET Marketplace, bringing together vehicle manufacturers, financiers, charging operators and freight stakeholders.
- PACT aims to aggregate freight demand from shippers, Logistics Service Providers (LSPs) and other stakeholders.
- It will help create deployment opportunities for zero-emission trucks across identified freight corridors.

High-Productivity Crop Diversification and Horticulture

10 September 2026

- Horticulture: 37 per cent of crop sub-sector gross value output; production 370.74 mt (2024-25) – vegetables 217.80, fruits 117.65, others 35.29
- Walnut: 3.22 lakh tonnes (2024-25); exports \$7.80 million; mainly from Jammu & Kashmir
- Decadal agricultural growth: 4.45 per cent
- India is second globally in fruits and vegetables; first in onions and shallots (22.42 per cent)

10 September 2026

- Related: PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana (rooftop solar), PM Surya Sarovar Yojana (floating solar, ₹5,070 crore, 5,000 MW), National Solar Mission
- PM-KUSUM launched 2019, under the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy; full form: Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha evam Utthaan Mahabhiyan
- Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha evam Utthaan Mahabhiyan, launched 2019
- India's solar capacity rose from about 3 GW (2016) to over 160 GW (mid-2026)

Dr. Karim Maredia Wins 2026 Borlaug CAST Communication Award

10 September 2026

- Dr. Karim Maredia, an Indian-American agricultural scientist, was named the winner of the Borlaug CAST Communication Award 2026.
- Over more than 30 years, he has trained 15,000+ professionals from 80 countries and contributed extensively to agricultural knowledge and technology transfer.
- The award honours communication and outreach in agricultural science and technology and is associated with the legacy of Nobel laureate Norman Borlaug.
- He is Associate Dean and Director of the World Agriculture Center at Michigan State University.

UNCCD COP17

11 September 2026

- Established following the 1992 Rio Earth Summit
- 40 per cent of global land degraded; Mongolia 77 per cent
- About 30 per cent of India's land is degraded (SAC-ISRO Atlas)
- UNCCD — adopted Paris, 17 June 1994; one of the three Rio Conventions with the UNFCCC and CBD; the only legally binding agreement on land management; 197 Parties

9th Rashtriya Poshan Maah 2026

11 September 2026

- Observed from 9 September to 8 October 2026
- Central theme: "Hamari Anganwadi Hamari Jimmedari" — calling on every citizen to take shared ownership of Anganwadi centres
- Dietary diversity and adequate protein
- Community ownership and accountability

Proposed Article 371(K) for Ladakh

11 September 2026

- Under the J&K Reorganisation Act, 2019, Ladakh was carved out as a Union Territory without a legislative assembly
- The Ministry of Home Affairs proposed inserting a new constitutional provision — Article 371(K), as Chapter K under Part XXI — to establish a directly elected governing body with legislative powers for the Union Territory of Ladakh.
- Providing a directly elected UT-level governing body with legislative authority over specified subjects

NIT Rourkela, ISRO–NRSC and Tea Board Sign MoU for CHAYANKAN

11 September 2026

- It will run from April 2026 to March 2029, with NIT Rourkela, ISRO–NRSC and Tea Board of India as key partners.
- It will use satellite imagery, UAV hyperspectral data, ground observations and Artificial Intelligence.

Bihar Partners with UAE's AIM Global Foundation to Set Up Food Processing Park

11 September 2026

- It can also connect farmers and local processors with international food supply chains.

Assisted Reproductive Technologies in Bovine Breeding

13 & 14 September 2026

- NLM — National Livestock Mission, since 2014–15, revised 2021–22; supports entrepreneurship, breed improvement and feed and fodder security
- 2009 — the world's first buffalo calf cloned using the Hand-guided Cloning Technique, at ICAR–NDRI, Karnal
- 2025 — India's first cloned cattle, a Gir female calf named GANGA, produced at ICAR–NDRI using OPU for oocyte collection and SCNT for embryo reconstruction
- RGM outlay: realigned for 2021–22 to 2025–26 with ₹2,400 crore, enhanced by ₹1,000 crore in March 2025, taking the total to ₹3,400 crore for the 15th Finance Commission cycle

ICAR–IVRI Produces Sahiwal Calves Through OPU–IVF–ET

13 & 14 September 2026

- Began in 2022–23, to strengthen the genetic potential of India's prized dairy breeds
- Aim: standardise OPU–IVF–ET protocols under both farm and field conditions

Moth Bean

13 & 14 September 2026

- Cultivated on nearly 10 lakh hectares; yield about 350 kg per hectare
- Survived a 35-day dry spell (3 August – 7 September 2026) in Kharif 2026
- Four newly developed moth bean varieties — CAZRI Moth-4, 5, 6 and 7 — by ICAR–Central Arid Zone Research Institute (CAZRI) demonstrated remarkable field resilience during an El Niño year in Kharif 2026, surviving a 35-day dry spell.
- Thrives in low and erratic rainfall, poor sandy soils with low organic carbon and fertility, and

temperatures exceeding 40°C

Schizopygopsis waddellii Recorded in India

13 & 14 September 2026

- In India, found in Pangkang Teng Tso Lake, at 12,800 feet, in Tawang district, Arunachal Pradesh

Grow Indigo Pays Farmers for Agricultural Carbon Credits

15 September 2026

- Reduced methane emissions by nearly 90%.
- Agri-tech startup Grow Indigo has paid around 2,500 farmers ₹3,000–₹15,000 each for more than 57,000 agricultural carbon credits. The company made the payment from its own funds, even though the carbon credits have not yet been completely sold to buyers.
- DSR: Rice seeds are directly sown in the field, avoiding the need to first grow seedlings in a nursery and then transplant them.
- Carbon Credit: A tradable certificate representing the reduction or removal of a specified amount of greenhouse-gas emissions, generally 1 tonne of CO₂-equivalent.

Grass Mache Technique

15 September 2026

- Wular Lake in J&K is a Ramsar Site; Hokersar, Surinsar-Mansar and Tsomoriri are others in the region
- Dal Lake is managed by the Lakes Conservation and Management Authority (LCMA), formerly LAWDA

Moth Bean

15 September 2026

- Varieties CAZRI Moth-4, 5, 6 and 7 survived a 35-day dry spell (3 August – 7 September 2026)
- Four newly developed moth bean varieties – CAZRI Moth-4, 5, 6 and 7 – by ICAR-Central Arid Zone Research Institute (CAZRI), Jodhpur demonstrated remarkable field-level resilience during an El Niño year in Kharif 2026.
- Thrives in extremely low and erratic rainfall, poor sandy soils with low organic carbon and fertility, and ambient temperatures exceeding 40°C
- Regional rainfall 150–250 mm; normal dry spells of 20–30 days

Ophiopogon japonicus Recorded for the First Time in India

15 September 2026

- Ophiopogon japonicus, an evergreen perennial herb, was recorded for the first time in India from West Kameng district, Arunachal Pradesh.

- The species is mainly found in China, Japan and Korea, generally at elevations of 200–2,800 metres.

Badri Cattle

16 & 17 September 2026

- The first Badri calf through OPU-IVF was born 11 September 2026, from a Sahiwal surrogate, in a collaboration between ICAR-NDRI Karnal and GBPUAT Pantnagar, funded by the Uttarakhand Biotechnology Council, Haldi
- The first cattle breed from Uttarakhand to be officially certified and registered by ICAR's NBAGR
- The first Uttarakhand cattle breed registered by NBAGR

PM Kisan Maandhan Yojana Completes Seven Years

16 & 17 September 2026

- Launched in 2019 by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare
- On 12 September 2026, the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Maandhan Yojana (PM-KMY) completed seven years – a voluntary contributory pension scheme for the old-age social security of Small and Marginal Farmers (SMFs).
- PM-KMY launched 2019; completed seven years on 12 September 2026
- Offers eligible landholding SMFs a steady monthly pension from the age of 60

GOBARdhan Scheme Guidelines Rolled Out

16 & 17 September 2026

- Launched: 2018
- The government notified detailed operational guidelines for the ₹23,731 crore GOBARdhan scheme, to develop India's compressed biogas (CBG) sector – assuring full offtake and introducing a pricing mechanism. The Cabinet approved the scheme last month.
- Ministry: Ministry of Jal Shakti
- Initially launched under: Swachh Bharat Mission-Grameen (SBM-G)

9th ASEAN-India Ministerial Meeting on Agriculture and Forestry

16 & 17 September 2026

- The 9th ASEAN-India Ministerial Meeting on Agriculture and Forestry (AIMMAF) was held in New Delhi on 9 September 2026.
- India-ASEAN trade in goods reached USD 128 billion in FY2025–26.

Dryland Congress 2026 and Delhi Declaration

on Drylands

16 & 17 September 2026

- The event also marked 50 years of the ICAR–ICRISAT partnership.
- Dryland Congress 2026 concluded in New Delhi with the Delhi Declaration on Drylands (3D).

Mangrove GIS Portal Launched in Gujarat

16 & 17 September 2026

- Gujarat has restored 27,652 hectares of mangroves under MISHTI, against the 2023–27 target of 29,250 hectares.

New Amphibian Species 'Gegeneophis chandgadi' Discovered

16 & 17 September 2026

- The discovery takes the number of Gegeneophis species recorded in India to 12, with 11 endemic to the Western Ghats.

The Cheetah and Project Cheetah

18 September 2026

- Declared extinct in India in 1952; the last were reportedly shot in Koriya, present-day Chhattisgarh
- Project Cheetah launched 17 September 2022 at Kuno, with 8 cheetahs from Namibia; 12 more from South Africa in February 2023
- The fastest living terrestrial animal, accelerating from 0 to 100 km/h in about three seconds
- Cheetah population: 52 — 49 at Kuno, 3 at Gandhi Sagar; 32 cubs born in India

Gegeneophis chandgadi

18 September 2026

- ZSI — Zoological Survey of India, established 1916, headquartered at Kolkata, under the MoEFCC
- Described by the Zoological Survey of India and Savitribai Phule Pune University
- Caecilians form the order Gymnophiona — the third order of amphibians, alongside Anura (frogs and toads) and Caudata/Urodela (salamanders and newts)
- Notable: the species was found in a human-modified backyard, not pristine forest — showing agroecosystems free of pesticides can hold undescribed biodiversity

PM Vishwakarma Completes Three Years

18 September 2026

- On 17 September 2026, the PM Vishwakarma Scheme completed three years, reaching 30 lakh registrations. The Ministry of MSME marked the anniversary at the Dhono Dhanyo Auditorium, Kolkata, West Bengal.

- PM Vishwakarma launched 17 September 2023, on Vishwakarma Jayanti; completed three years with 30 lakh registrations
- Covers 18 traditional trades
- Outlay: ₹13,000 crore for FY2023–24 to FY2027–28

Kishau Multipurpose Project Agreement Signed by Six States

18 September 2026

- The project is a National Project, with 90% funding by the Centre and 10% by the participating state
- The 422 MW project will support water storage, irrigation and the rejuvenation of the Yamuna River.
- A 232.6-metre-high concrete gravity dam will be built on the Tons River with 1,562 MCM storage capacity.

FAO Report: "Forests for Food"

19 September 2026

- 1.8 billion people (23 per cent of the global population) relied primarily on woodfuel for cooking in 2022; 410 million depended on wood energy to boil and sterilise drinking water
- Over 5 billion people depend to some extent on forests for livelihoods; forests generate up to 20 per cent of rural household income in several developing regions
- In remote forest-dependent communities, wild forest foods supply up to 80 per cent of daily dietary protein and nearly half of total food mass by weight
- Forests host pollinators supporting 35 per cent of global crop production; forested watersheds supply freshwater to over 85 per cent of the world's major cities

India's First Soil Carbon Payments

19 September 2026

- Initiated in 2019 to curb air pollution from paddy stubble burning in northwestern India and reverse groundwater depletion in the Indo-Gangetic plains
- The first payment cycle covers carbon sequestered and emissions avoided between 2019 and 2022
- India's agricultural carbon market reached a milestone as 2,550+ small farmers in Punjab and Haryana received over ₹2.9 crore through DBT — India's first farm-level soil carbon payments for verified regenerative farming practices.
- Rewarding smallholder farmers for regenerative, climate-smart agronomic practices

Stage	How It Works
1. Field Practice Adoption	Farmers adopt Direct Seeded Rice (DSR) , minimum tillage , cover crops , and in-situ residue retention , replacing conventional transplanting and stubble burning .

- The action was taken under Section 45-IA(6) of the RBI Act, 1934.
- The five cancellations were Dar's Financial Services, Rolta Holding and Finance Corporation, Vasudeo Securities, Parsoli Corporation and A C Choksi Financial Services.
- Among the surrendered licences, some entities exited the NBFC business, while others were merged/dissolved or reclassified as entities not requiring NBFC registration.

RBI Net Purchases Record \$18.65 Billion in July

27 & 28 September 2026

- The RBI net purchased \$18.65 billion in foreign exchange in July 2026, the highest monthly purchase on record.
- This was sharply higher than the \$561 million net purchase in June 2026 and slightly above the previous record of \$18.63 billion in June 2021.
- The increase was linked to the RBI's concessional swap facility for FCNR(B) deposits, external commercial borrowings and overseas foreign-currency borrowings.
- The facility attracted \$40.82 billion of inflows by July-end, with banks routing the foreign currency back to the RBI through the swap window.

5 September 2026

- The United Nations General Assembly adopted a resolution on 4 September 2026 to observe 27 November every year as the International Day for the Elimination of Child Marriage.

UN Declares November 27 as International Day for Elimination of Child Marriage

6 & 7 September 2026

- The UN General Assembly adopted a resolution to observe 27 November annually as the International Day for the Elimination of Child Marriage.

UNGA Declares November 27 as International Day Against Child Marriage

8 September 2026

- The first observance will take place on 27 November 2026.
- India was among the 70 co-sponsors of the resolution, which was adopted without a vote.
- The United Nations General Assembly adopted a resolution declaring November 27 as the International Day for the Elimination of Child, Early and Forced Marriage.

WhatsApp Introduces Bill Payments Through Bharat Connect

8 September 2026

- The service provides access to 22,722 billers across 30 categories.
- Users can pay electricity, gas, water, FASTag, insurance, credit-card and loan bills.

Article 371(K) Proposed for Ladakh

10 September 2026

- The Union Ministry of Home Affairs proposed a new

constitutional provision described as Chapter K under Article 371 for Ladakh.

- The proposal was discussed in a sub-committee meeting on 9 September 2026.
- Article 371 provisions provide special arrangements for specific States; the proposed framework would address the unique administrative and socio-cultural concerns of Ladakh.

Stanzin Tsangyang Becomes Kargil's First Woman Army Officer

10 September 2026

- Stanzin Tsangyang was commissioned into the Indian Army on 5 September 2026 at the Officers Training Academy in Chennai.
- She became the first woman officer from the Zaskar region of Ladakh.

US-India TRUST Fellowship 2026-27

11 September 2026

- The 12-month programme focuses on AI, quantum computing, semiconductors, biotechnology, energy, defence and space technologies.
- Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE) was selected as one of three Indian host institutions for the US-India TRUST Fellowship 2026-27.
- Fellows receive financial and logistical support, including a USD 1,650 monthly stipend, housing, insurance and travel support.

International Day to Protect Education from Attack 2026

11 September 2026

- The UN observes this day on 9 September to protect students, teachers and educational institutions in conflict zones.
- The 2026 theme is "Can Education Survive Attack? The Resilience of Human Communities."
- The day was established through UNGA Resolution A/RES/74/275 in 2020.

International Literacy Day 2026

11 September 2026

- The year 2026 marks 60 years since UNESCO proclaimed the day in 1966.
- The 2026 theme is "Literacy for people, the planet and prosperity."
- International Literacy Day is observed every year on 8 September.

India-US TRUST Initiative for Undersea Cable Networks

12 September 2026

- India and the United States are expanding

cooperation on undersea cable networks under the US–India TRUST Initiative.

- Undersea cables are critical for international internet connectivity and secure digital communications.

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- It was established by the UN through Resolution A/RES/74/275 in 2020.

Rajnath Singh's Visit to Sri Lanka

15 September 2026

- It was the first visit by an Indian Defence Minister to Sri Lanka in nearly 40 years.
- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh visited Sri Lanka from 8–10 September 2026 to strengthen defence and maritime security cooperation.

International Day of Democracy 2026

16 & 17 September 2026

- The first observance was held in 2008.
- The 2026 theme is "Bring human rights into focus."
- The UN General Assembly officially declared 15 September as the International Day of Democracy in 2007.
- The International Day of Democracy is observed on 15 September to promote democratic values and institutions.

- The date marks the signing of the Montreal Protocol in 1987.

Article 371 and Asymmetric Federalism

18 September 2026

- Original purpose (1950) — not for cultural or tribal autonomy. It was a transitional administrative mechanism placing erstwhile princely states (Part B States such as Mysore, Hyderabad and Rajasthan) under Presidential supervision for 10 years
- 371J covers Kalyana-Karnataka, added by the 98th Amendment, 2012
- 1956 reset — the 7th Constitutional Amendment Act abolished the Part A, B and C state classifications; the original Article 371 was replaced to provide development boards for Maharashtra and Gujarat
- LAHDC Leh (1995) and LAHDC Kargil (2003) operate under the LAHDC Act, 1997

Hazard Perception Test

18 September 2026

- Kerala — the first State to make the Hazard Perception Test mandatory, from December 2026
- Driving licences in India are issued by State Transport Authorities / RTOs under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988
- Related: the Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Act, 2019, which introduced electronic enforcement (136A), Good Samaritan protection (134A), Golden Hour cashless treatment (162), contractor liability (198A) and vehicle recall (110A)
- Kerala will become the first State in India to introduce a mandatory computer-based Hazard Perception Test (HPT) for driving licence applicants, from December 2026.

Stem Cell Therapy for Autism Restricted to Approved Clinical Trials

18 September 2026

- The advisory follows the Supreme Court judgment of 30 January 2026 in Yash Charitable Trust & Ors. v. Union of India & Ors.
- The advisory was issued on 16 September 2026 and reiterates the existing regulatory framework for stem cell therapy.
- The Union Health Ministry directed States and UTs to ensure that stem cell therapy for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) is provided only through duly approved clinical trials.

Registration of Births and Deaths Amendment Act, 2026

20 & 21 September 2026

- The Registration of Births and Deaths (Amendment) Act, 2026 will come into force from 1 October 2026.
- Births and deaths must generally be reported within 21 days of occurrence.

- Delayed registration after one year and up to two years will require approval from the District Magistrate, SDM or authorised Executive Magistrate.
- Registration delayed by more than two years will require an order from the Judicial Magistrate First Class (JMFC).

Nasha Mukh Bharat Abhiyaan Partnership with The Art of Living

20 & 21 September 2026

- DoSJE extended its partnership with The Art of Living to strengthen substance-abuse prevention and awareness.

- Consumers who do not complete authentication can still obtain LPG through specified channels, but subsidised refills at the regulated price will not be available.

25 & 26 September 2026

- The Supreme Court delivered a split verdict on whether challenges to the Act should be heard by a five-judge Constitution Bench; the matter has been referred accordingly.

The West Bengal Anti-Goonda Bill, 2026

27 & 28 September 2026

- Reports said the President returned the Bill for reconsideration after the Centre raised concerns about possible overlap with the NDPS Act, 1985 and the PITNDPS Act, 1988.
- The West Bengal Public Safety and Control of Anti-Social Activities Bill, 2026 was passed by the West Bengal Assembly in June 2026.
- The Bill deals with habitual offenders, organised crime and threats to public order, and includes provisions for preventive detention.
- There was subsequently a conflicting public statement from West Bengal Chief Minister Suvenudh Adhikari, who said the Bill was still under consideration of the Union Home Ministry. Therefore, the procedural status should be treated with care.
